



## First Grade Supply List for Ms. Detweiler's Class

Welcome to the wonderful world of first grade. Please be sure to open all supplies and put in your child's pouch. The first days of school are so busy and it will be hard to open everyone's supplies. Please be sure to label notebooks and folders on the inside and I will provide labels for the outside. Thank you in advance for all your support to have your child prepared for a great FIRST YEAR at Oxhead Elementary School!

- 2 boxes of **Crayola** Crayons: 1 for beginning of the year and one for mid year
- 25 **Sharpened Ticonderoga** pencils (5 in supply pouches daily-the rest can stay at home for when they are lost or need to be replenished)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's white glue
- 1 pack of lined Post-It notes
- 5 large glue sticks (only 1 needs to be in their supply pouch daily)
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors (rounded tip please)
- 1 eraser
- 2 marble notebooks-if you can find wide ruled great! No worries otherwise (only one is necessary daily for now)
- 2 plastic or sturdy folders
- 1 clipboard
- 1 highlighter any color
- 1 ruler with standard and metric units of measurement (please keep at home until we need it later in the year)
- 1 pack of **TWISTABLE** 16-24 (or less) of colored pencils. Please **DO NOT** purchase colored pencils that need to be sharpened. Thank You
- 1 personal pencil sharpener
- 1 **large canvas supply case** to hold above supplies in (boxes are too rigid-canvas is easier to place in desks)
- Eraser caps for when pencils are still good but erasers are worn down (you can be kept at home until needed)

Please be sure to stick to this supply list. No other extras are necessary. I do not allow personal markers, so please do not send them into school.

**PLEASE REMEMBER TO SEND IN A HEALTHY SNACK AND DRINK DAILY FOR YOUR CHILD! WE GET VERY HUNGRY IN FIRST GRADE!**
