Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please be advised that most remaining January Winter Concerts are being postponed to February. New dates can be found on the second page of this letter.

As previously mentioned, to comply with social distancing guidelines, audience attendance will need to be limited. Your music teacher will let students know the maximum number of guests each student can bring.
