Classes at Suffolk County Community College this summer, 2020, for the Early College Program will be online if the current situation remains the same. Course meeting times are subject to change, if in person or online classes take place. Please select the classes in which you wish to enroll, sign and return to your child's guidance counselor.

Registration is due Tuesday, May 19, 2020

General information:

- Classes are \$57 per credit, which is \$171 for a 3-credit class, \$228 for a 4-credit class. Credit values are on the registration page.
- Classes open to current 10th and 11th Grade students only.
- Tuition is to be paid to the College directly; they will contact you for billing.
- Placement testing on campus will not take place; instead all grades (Q1-3 this year, previous transcript, and any PSAT/SAT/ACT grades) will be submitted instead.
- Students need an 85 cumulative average to apply.
- Counselors will forward signed application, along with all grades and assessments, to the College for review.
- The College will communicate directly to you regarding class and financial information.
