Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State has revised immunization requirements for the 2015/2016 school year effective September 1, 2015. Please review the information listed below and contact your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child(ren) received all the required immunizations. This list reflects the basic requirements for entering school by grade levels.

Should your child(ren) not meet the mandated immunization requirements as of the close of school on September 25, 2015, they will be excluded from school until the school nurse has received confirmation of the immunizations or, a card from your child's physician indicating an appointment has been scheduled for your child to receive the additional immunizations to meet the State requirements.

Proof of immunization must be **any 1 of the 3** items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases
- For Varicella (chickenpox) we will accept a note from your health care provider indicating your child has had the disease and, on what date

➤ Pre-K students:

DTP - DtaP - 4 DOSES
POLIO – 3 DOSES
MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA (MMR) 1 DOSE
HEPATITIS B – 3 DOSES
VARICELLA (CHICKENPOX) - 1 DOSE
HIB – 1 TO 4 DOSES
PCV (PNEUMONIA) 1 TO 4 DOSES

➤ Kindergarten and 1st grade students:

DTP – DtaP – 5 DOSES
POLIO – 4 DOSES
MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA (MMR) 2 DOSES or, 2 DOSES OF MEASLER AND MUMPS AND 1 DOSE OF RUBELLA
HEPATITIS B – 3 DOSES
VARICELLA (CHICKENPOX) - 2 DOSES

- **2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students:**
 - DTP – DtaP – 5 DOSES**
 - POLIO – 3 DOSES**
 - MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA (MMR) 2 DOSES, or 2 DOSES OF MEASLES AND MUMPS AND 1 DOSE OF RUBELLA**
 - HEPATITIS B – 3 DOSES**
 - VARICELLA (CHICKENPOX) 2 DOSES**

- **6th and 7th grade students:**
 - DTP – DtaP – 5 DOSES**
 - Tdap – 1 DOSE**
 - POLIO – 4 DOSES**
 - MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA (MMR) 2 DOSES, or 2 DOSES OF MEASLES AND MUMPS AND 1 DOSE OF RUBELLA**
 - HEPATITIS B – 3 DOSES (SEE YOUR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER)**
 - VARICELLA (CHICKENPOX) 2 DOSES**

- **8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th grade students:**
 - DTP-DtaP – 3 DOSES**
 - Tdap – 1 DOSE**
 - POLIO – 3 DOSES**
 - MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA (MMR) – 2 DOSES, or 2 DOSES OF MEASLES AND MUMPS AND 1 DOSE OF RUBELLA**
 - HEPATITIS B - 3, 2 DOSES (SEE YOUR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER)**
 - VARICELLA (CHICKENPOX) 1 DOSE**

Please check with your health care provider should you have questions regarding unreported immunizations or, what immunizations may still be required.
