



Welcome to Kindergarten



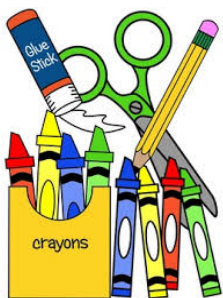
Dear Parents/Families,

SCHOOL SUPPLIES NEEDED

Label and send into school . Supplies will not be shared.

Please bring these items on the FIRST DAY of school.

- ★ Backpack (large enough to fit a folder, lunch bag and Chromebook) (LABELED)
- ★ Lunch bag for lunch and snack (LABELED)
- ★ One pocket folder (bottom pockets only please) (LABELED)
- ★ One hard plastic pencil box to hold supplies (approx. 8 ½ x 5 ½ in.) (LABELED) *Please do not send in smaller sized boxes or bags.

IN YOUR SUPPLY BOX YOU SHOULD HAVE...

(please put in your child's supply box for the first day)

- ★ 4 sharpened pencils
- ★ One box of 24 Crayola crayons (LABEL BOX WITH CHILD'S NAME)
- ★ One pair Fiskar scissors (blunt edge, LABELED and out of package)
- ★ One large glue stick (fat ones work the best and last longer) (LABELED)
- ★ One THIN YELLOW highlighter (LABELED)
- ★ One large pink eraser

Within the first two weeks, please send in the remainder of the supplies in a Ziploc Bag labeled with your child's name...

- ★ A pair of CHILD headphones/earbuds to be used with their Chromebook. PLEASE try them on your child to be sure they fit comfortably on/in your child's ears. Tiny ears need tiny headphones! It is not necessary to spend a great deal of money. Please decide what you feel is an appropriate amount to spend. We will use them weekly and they should be exciting for your child!
- ★ One 4 or 6 pack of THIN DRY ERASE MARKERS. Expo Markers work the best!
- ★ One additional pocket folder (bottom pockets) (LABELED)
- ★ One package/box of sharpened pencils
- ★ One additional pink eraser
- ★ One box of colored pencils
- ★ One additional box 24 Crayola crayons (LABEL BOX)
- ★ One package Crayola BROAD LINE markers (LABEL BOX)
- ★ 4 LARGE Elmer's glue sticks (LABELED)
- ★ Two additional THIN YELLOW highlighters (LABELED)
- ★ Two packages of wipes
- ★ One 4 pack Playdough to be used for your child only (LABELED)

Please do not send your child to school with a small pencil sharpener. It is a safety issue.

Other Important Information

Absent notes MUST accompany your child upon his/her return to school with the date and the reason for absence clearly stated. It is crucial that we be notified if your child has been exposed to Covid or tests positive for Covid.

If you are picking your child up early, please send in a note on the day you'll be picking your child up early.

YOU MUST SHOW PHOTO ID.

A snack time will be reserved each day. Please send in a nutritious snack and drink (i.e. fruit, crackers, cheese, vegetable sticks). Please no candy and please limit unhealthy snacks..

Please make sure that your child knows in advance if they are buying lunch and what they are buying. It is also very helpful for your child to have their snack items separate from their lunch items. Please discuss with your child what is for snack and what is for lunch prior to school each day.
